

FEMALES IN TRAINING COMMITTEE CODE OF CONDUCT

A member of the Management Committee (or a Sub-Committee) of FIT is expected to:

- act in good faith with the degree of care and skill, which may be reasonably expected from a person with her knowledge and experience, in the best interests of the service;
- exercise the powers conferred on her as a Committee member only for the purpose for which they were conferred;
- ensure that the service operates in keeping with the relevant legislation and funding agreement;
- avoid and disclose any conflict of interest between her personal/family affairs and those of the service as a whole:
- keep confidential discussion of matters at Committee meetings;
- carry out all work she agrees to do responsibly and ethically; and
- see herself and others as valued Committee members with the duty to contribute to decision making by attending meetings, asking questions and acting conscientiously.

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
